Nomination for Induction of Fellows and Applications for the Awards of IASWC for 2024 are invited as per details given in this announcement. In a year, a Life Member cannot make **more than one nomination**. **The last date for receiving the nominations / applications in the prescribed proforma at the Association's Office is** 28th February, 2025.</sup>

1. FELLOWS

Nominations are invited from Life Members of IASWC for Fellowship which is conferred on an individual *in recognition of his / her professional outstanding contributions and service to the IASWC.* The number of persons bestowed with Fellowship each year shall not exceed **three**.

To be eligible as a nominee for the Fellowship, an individual must be *Life Member for a period of atleast 10 years and having 15 years experience in Natural Resource Management and significant contribution to the Association.* Nominations should be made in each case at least by TWO Life Members in the prescribed proforma (enclosed with this announcement as **Annexure - I**). Nominations once made shall remain valid for three years. The inducted Fellows shall be presented with a **Memento** and a **Citation**.

2. DR K.G. TEJWANI AWARD FOR MANAGEMENT (RESEARCH / TRAINING / DEVELOPMENT) OF NATURAL RESOURCES (BIENNIUM 2022-2023)

Nominations are invited from Indian citizens for "*Dr K.G. Tejwani Award" biennium 2022-20*23" having minimum **10** years experience in Management (Research / Training / Development) of Natural Resources in the prescribed proforma (enclosed with this announcement as **Annexure - II)**. The Award, to be conferred once in two years (biennial), was instituted during 1992-93 in the name of the Founder President of the Association, Late Dr K.G. Tejwani and the present award is 16th in the series.
