Inviting Nominations for Fellowship and Application for Awards of IASWC for 2025

Nomination for Induction of Fellows and Applications for the Awards of IASWC for 2025 are invited as per the details given in this announcement. In a year, a Life Member cannot make **more than one nomination**. **The last date for receiving the nominations / applications in the prescribed proforma at the Association's Office is 28th February, 2026.**

1. FELLOWS

The IASWC Fellowship is awarded to recognize life members who have demonstrated exceptional professional achievements and dedicated service to the field of natural resource management and especially to the IASWC over an extended period. It honors excellence in research, development, and organizational service. The number of persons bestowed with Fellowship each year shall not exceed four.

Nominations are invited from the eligible Life Members of IASWC for Fellowship. To be eligible as a nominee for the Fellowship, an individual must be ***Life Member for a period of at least 10 years and having 15 years' experience in Natural Resource Management and significant contribution to the Association.*** Nominations should be made in each case at least by TWO Life Members in the prescribed proforma (enclosed with this announcement as **Annexure - I**). Nominations once made shall remain valid for three years. The inducted Fellows shall be presented with a **Memento** and a **Citation**.

2. DR DARSHANA NAND PURI AWARD FOR NATURAL RESOURCE CONSERVATION AND WATERSHED MANAGEMENT (BIENNIUM 2023-2024)

The Indian Association of Soil and Water Conservationists, Dehradun initiated a new award in the year 2021-22 in the name of the **Founder Member** of the Association, **Late Dr Darshana Nand Puri** to acknowledge *mid and late-career professionals (45-62 years)* with significant achievements in *research, training, and development* related to natural resource conservation, particularly soil and water conservation and watershed management. The Award, to be conferred once in two years (biennial), called **Dr Darshana Nand Puri Award for Natural Resource Conservation and Watershed Management**, the present Award is 4th in the series. The Award carry's a **Plaque, ₹ 30,000/- in Cheque** and a **Citation**.

Application are invited from Indian citizens of age between 45 to 62, having minimum 10 years' experience in Research, Training and Development in **Natural Resource Conservation (Soil and Water Conservation and Watershed Management)**. The format of application and other relevant details are enclosed with this announcement as **Annexure - II**.

A Demand Draft or through Electronic Transfer of ₹ **500/- (Rupees Five Hundred)** only favouring **Indian Association of Soil and Water Conservationists** payable at Dehradun should be sent to the IASWC Office.

3. IASWC GOLD MEDAL (RESEARCHER / SCIENTIST, FIELD FUNCTIONARY AND TECHNICAL PROFESSIONAL)

The IASWC Gold Medal awards have been instituted to honour IASWC life members who have made *noteworthy contributions to the association and to the cause of soil and water conservation* through research, field implementation, or technical innovations during the preceding decade. Applications are invited in the prescribed proforma (enclosed with this announcement as **Annexure - III** for Researcher /Scientist, **Annexure - IV** for Field Functionary, and **Annexure - V** for Technical Professional) from the Life Members of IASWC,irrespective of age, ***in recognition of his / her contribution and service to the Association during the last ten years.*** The awardee shall be presented with a **Gold Medal** and a **Citation**.

NOTE:-The individual who have already been conferred the Fellow Award shall not be eligible to apply for any IASWC GOLD MEDAL.

4. IASWC YOUNG SCIENTIST AWARD

This award given annually to an individual *in recognition of his / her in-service contributions for a maximum duration of 10 years (2015-2024) towards development, conservation and management of natural resources*, is open to Life Members of IASWC who are less than **40 years** of age as on **31st December, 2025**. Eligible Life Members can apply for this Award in the prescribed proforma (enclosed with this announcement as **Annexure - VI**). The awardee shall be presented with a **Memento** and a **Citation**. *(Minimum duration of IASWC life membership is 5 years)*

5. IASWC YOUNG SOIL CONSERVATIONISTS (FIELD FUNCTIONARY) AWARD

The award intends to encourage and reward *young field professionals (below 40 years)* who have demonstrated *exemplary on-ground efforts* and technical excellence in soil and water conservation and watershed management. This award given annually to an individual *in recognition of his/her in-service contributions for a maximum duration of 10 years (2015-2024) towards development, conservation and management of natural resources*, is open to Life Members of IASWC who are less than **40 years** of age as on **31st December, 2025**. Eligible Life Members can apply for this Award in the prescribed proforma (enclosed with this announcement as **Annexure - VII**). The awardee shall be presented with a **Memento** and a **Citation**.

6. IASWC BUDDING SCIENTIST AWARD

To motivate *emerging researchers (below 35 years)* who have shown *early promise in scientific work* and contributed to the development and dissemination of soil and water conservation technologies during the last five years, a new award initiated called **IASWC Budding Scientist Award** during 2020 and the present Award is 6th in the series. This award given annually to an individual *in recognition of his / her in-service contributions for a maximum duration of 5 years (2020-2024) towards development, conservation and management of natural resources*, is open to Life Members of IASWC who are less than **35 years** of age as on **31st December, 2025**. Eligible Life Members can apply for this Award in the prescribed proforma (enclosed with this announcement as **Annexure - VIII**). The awardee shall be presented with a **Memento** and a **Citation**. *(minimum duration of IASWC life membership is 2 years)*

7. Best M.Sc. & Ph. D. THESIS AWARD

To promote *high-quality academic research* in soil and water conservation by recognizing outstanding postgraduate and doctoral theses aligned with the mandate areas of IASWC a new award initiated called **Best M.Sc. & Ph. D. thesis Award** and the present Award is 1st in the series. This award given annually to an individual *in recognition of his / her research contribution in the field of Soil and Water Conservation. For the eligibility, no objection certification from guide is must. Thesis topic should be related to IASWC mandate areas. Thesis should not be more than 05 years old in case of Ph. D and not more than 02 years old in case of M.Sc. from the final viva voce date. Only those are considered for this Award for which the final viva-voce is completed by 31st December of the year (2025) for which the award is applied* (enclosed with this announcement as **Annexure - IX**). *The award carries only a citation.*

Students/researchers in the field of soil and water conservation interested to apply for this Award are required to send his/her application along with endorsement from Head of the Department. Only two proposals will be considered from each University/Institution. Also a copy of synopsis, highlighting the significance of research, a certificate from the concerned Head of the Department that the research work of the candidate has been a significant factor in obtaining the data presented in the thesis leading to the conferment of M.Sc./Ph.D. degree in soil and water conservation and that the work has not been submitted for any other award, a copy of Thesis in PDF format and all other required documents as mentioned in the application form.

8. BEST RESEARCH PAPER AWARD

To honour *excellence in scientific publication* by selecting the most impactful research papers published in the *Indian Journal of Soil Conservation* across five disciplines—Engineering & Hydrology, Soil Science, Agronomy, Forestry & Agroforestry, and Social Science, annually, five best research paper awards are being given one in each category. based on the scientific contribution of the articles published in **Indian Journal of Soil Conservation** during the year **2025**.
